Smart move for mobiles

Symbian, Psion's joint venture with Nokia, Ericsson and Motorola, has been set up to produce the mobile technology of the future. The company, formed this summer, will deliver the technology for a new generation of mobile solutions, such as smartphones and communicators – two classes of new, digital devices that will increase dramatically the use of mobile computing and communications. By 2002, the world's population of mobile phone users will reach some 600 million – and some analysts believe that not long after, wireless connections will exceed fixed line links. Symbian's technologies will drive the convergence of mobile computing and wireless technology, enabling Internet access, messaging and information access, – all within a device that fits in a shirt pocket. Mobile users can look forward to:

- Smartphones digital phones on a GSM network with the capability to browse the Internet, and receive and send faxes, SMS and email. Smartphones might even have scheduling and contact management software built-in. Already announced is the Philips Synergy clip-on unit that adds organising capability to a mobile phone and which uses Symbian technology.
- Communicators that offer even richer functionality than smartphones. They will have keyboard input facilities, the ability to link seamlessly with a PC, with printers, and with the Internet to send and receive files, to synchronise seamlessly and to be practical to carry around. The result: a powerful palmtop computer and digital phone in one unit.





- The calculation of journeys in route-finding software such as Route Planner is more speedy.
- The 3mx boosts Sheet's performance, so that cell recalculation, and inserting and deleting rows and columns, will happen a good deal faster.


The success of the Series 5 has led to a explosion in the number of Psion-compatible programs available on the Internet and on CD-ROM – there are now more than 450 Series 5 applications and utilities. The Series 3 range hasn't been forgotten either, with

many updates to some of the 2,000 existing programs to make use of the extra power of the Series 3mx.

Games are always popular on both Psion series, with pride of place perhaps going to *Pipeline*, an updated version of the old Pipemania classic puzzle. Rather than just extending a pipe to a certain length, you now have to battle your way around obstacles and towards a specified finishing point. Also impressive is *Mis5ile Defense*, a version of the 1980s arcade classic in which the Series 5's touch screen is used to its best effect in launching missiles at incoming invaders. *RMRBoxx* is the old Sokobox

crate-shoving game and **Frotz5** is a text adventure engine capable of running all the old Infocom games you used to love in the days before flashy in-game graphics.

On a more serious note, **ConvertPro** is a tremendously useful free unit conversion and formula calculation utility and **Macro5** is a macro system which lets you perform complex or repetitive operations at the press of a single key.

More than 100 small utilities are also available to transform your Series 5's interface, with application short-cuts (*ExtraBars*, *Shortcut Wizard*), Agenda plug-ins (*BusyView32*, *MonthManager*) and search tools (*JB5Utils*, *Ferret*), not to mention more than 60 macros for *Macro5*, each with its own dedicated function.

A wide range of reference software has grown up around the

Series 5, some commercial but others shareware, such as **ProcyonX** (an astronomy suite), **Piano** (a music aid, with chords, notes and beats), **UK Pocket Directory** (a 'yellow pages') and the freeware **Trivia** (great for pub quizzes).

With finance being so close to many of our hearts it's not surprising to see many programs dedicated to making the most of what we've got. *ABP*, *RMRBank* and *HomeBank* are just some of the contenders.

The Series 3 scene has understandably been a lot quieter in the last year, but most of the quality applications have been maintained and updated by their authors. In particular, look out for **Portfolio** (shares and investments), **Draw** and **Vector** (bitmap and vector graphics packages respectively) and **Plan** (a project management system).

All the programs can be downloaded from the Internet. Good places to look are the 3-Lib library (http://3lib.ukonline.co.uk), the links page of Psion's website (http://www.psion.com), and the Psionking site (http://www.psionking.com).



NEW Street march

Palmtop reckons it has stolen a march on the competition literally – with the release of Street Planner '99, a huge collection of maps that make it easy to find your way around all the major cities and towns in Europe. Described as 'door-to-door route planning in your pocket', the product is a companion to Route Planner, Palmtop's country route finding package, and promises to plan perfect routes within a city - as it 'knows' every road,

street and alley, and all traffic regulations. Street Planner shows which roads are one-way - and in which direction - and also highlights important locations, such as airports, railway stations and subway stations. Search facilities allow you to find any street in seconds, or any intersection between two streets, and the package will help you even if you don't know the correct spelling of the street name. Other features include the ability to 'zoom' to show more and more detail, the option to add your own locations - and find them with a single key press - and to 'put yourself on the map' by connecting up a GPS satellite receiver.

Like Palmtop's Route Planner, the city software allows you to calculate the quickest way to get to your destination, and to

avoid certain roads if you know they are closed or prone to traffic jams. It isn't just for car drivers you can also plot the shortest route on foot. Street Planner gives step by step instructions as you move along your chosen route.

Map in hand

Route Planner, Palmtop's country map product, is available for both the Series 5 and Series 3a/3c/3mx, although the Series 5 version has been redesigned to make optimal use of the larger screen, the pen and the speed of the latest Psion.

With the Series 5 version, you can display any section of the road map at various scales, and at varying levels of detail. There are several ways of displaying location names, routes, legends, locators and scales. Similarly, you can display driving instructions in several formats and at several levels of detail. In the 'split view' you can even follow your route graphically, on the map, as you go through the list of driving instructions. Additionally Route Planner allows you to add locations, and build 'collections', say of friends, customers, or historical sites.


